Models of action demonstrating how faith communities are responding to HIV in conjunction with community based organizations, and independently.

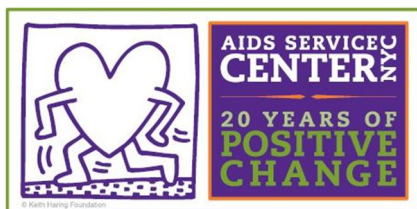
Our gathering will include both presentation and conversation, and we hope you'll add your voice by sharing your own successes, concerns, and ideas.
